GROUP B 5 - 8 YEARS (on the 31st Aug 2010)

- 5 Miniature country scene on a seed tray, using natural materials, max. size 24 x 38cm
- 6 An animal, made from fruit or vegetables, max. size 20cm overall
- 7 Collage of a scarecrow, max. size A4
- 8 Make a puppet using a wooden spoon
- 9 Floating flower heads in a saucer
- 10 Decorated poster, World Cup, or 20th Flower Show Anniversary, max. size A4
- 11 Lego model (not a kit), max. size 30 cm

- 23 2 decorated cupcakes
