## CATEGORIES FOR ENTRIES

Adult help with children's work should be ABSOLUTELY MINIMAL

### **GROUP A 0 - 4 YEARS** (on the 31st Aug 2011)

- 2 Playdough model of a mini beast – labelled with a description
- 3 Decorate a paper plate of "My favourite animal", any materials
- 4 Painting using hand/feet prints, max. size A4

### **GROUP B 5 - 8 YEARS** (on the 31st Aug 2011)

- 5 Miniature country scene on a seed tray, using natural materials, max. size 24 x 38cm
- 6 An animal, made from fruit or vegetables, max. size 20cm overall
- 7 Collage of a scarecrow, max. size A3
- 8 Make a mini kite, max. size A3, excluding tail
- 9 Floating flower heads in a saucer
- 10 Decorated poster, "The Queen's Diamond Jubilee" or "Olympics 2012", max. size A4
- 11 Model using recycled materials, max. size 30 cm
- 12 Edible necklace
- 13 2 edible decorated funny face biscuits
- 14 Potatoes in a bucket, heaviest crop \*\*

### **GROUP C 9 – 16 YEARS** (on the 31st Aug 2011)

- 15 Miniature country scene on a seed tray, using natural materials, max. size 24 x 38cm
- 16 Make a scarecrow, max. height 1.5 metres
- 17 Piece of art, any medium, max. size A3
- 18 Model using recycled materials, max. size 30 cm
- 19 Mounted photograph (on card), max. photo size A4 (photo to be taken by entrant)
- 20 Homemade sweets on a plate
- 21 Bunch of flowers in a Jam Jar
- 22 2 decorated cupcakes
- 23 Design a stained glass window, max. size A3
- 24 Potatoes in a bucket , heaviest crop \*\*
